
Your body is a bundle of bones, muscles, senses and nerves all connected together to make you a human. But do you know how these parts of your body work with your brain? Let's find out.

In **PE**, we'll be playing football and focusing on our ABCs (Agility, Balance and Coordination)

In English we will be learning about:

We will be reading the book 'Avocado Baby', where the students will be learning different strategies to help them understand what they are reading. In writing, students will be learning how to join their words together to write a sentence. We will be focusing on neat writing, and using full stops and capital letters. The children will also be learning how to write a recount of an event.

In Maths we will be learning about:

Autumn1: Numbers to 10, Addition and subtraction within 10 Autumn 2: Shapes and patterns, Numbers to 20 and Addition and subtraction within 20

In **Music**, we'll be:

- Exploring pitch and rhythm
- Performing music to the correct tempo, as a group

Art Year 1 will explore mark-making using a range of tools. They will represent line and shapes to sounds inspired by the abstract artist Wassily Kandinsky. Drawing from observation and imagination they will focus on creating expressive self-portraits and investigatie the role of the illustrator using Beatrix Potter as a starting point for illustrating their own story, working with iPads and mixed-media.
