In Reception our Understanding the World topics are fluid and do tend to change quickly as we follow the interests of the children however below is our current plan moving towards the end of Summer term. We currently have our role play area set up as a Minibeast Investigation Lab and will change it as the topics change.

In our **Minibeasts** topic we will be learning about:

- General facts about a range of minibeasts
- Looking at Non-fiction books about minibeasts
- Reading fiction stories about minibeasts eg. The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Grant the Ant, Spinderella, The Very Busy Spider
- Life cycles of different minibeasts eg. caterpillars, stick insects
- Observing real living caterpillars and stick insects

In our Dinosaurs/Vets /Space topic weeks we might explore the following:

- Different types of dinosaurs that lived.
- Exploring facts about dinosaurs
- Creating a dinosaur dig role play area
- How vets help our animals?
- How is this similar / different to a human hospital?
- How we can help to look after our animals?
- Why do animals need our help?
- Information and facts about Space and the Solar System
- All of the planets and what they are called.
- Facts about the different planets
- Who are astronauts? How do they prepare for Space and travel there? How do astronauts survive in Space?
- Explore Non-fiction books and stories about Space
