I Wonder How Big Our World Is?

We'll be discovering that:

- There are four countries that make up the United Kingdom. They are England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.
- The highest mountain in the UK is Ben Nevis.
- The longest river is the River Severn, flowing through England and Wales.
- Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica and Australia are the seven continents.
- The world's five oceans from smallest to largest are: the Arctic, Southern, Indian, Atlantic and Pacific Oceans.

From A to B

We'll be finding out:

- About transport in the past.
- How to make a timeline to show when different types of transport were invented.
- How children around the world travel to school.
- How transport used in the past compares to transport used now.

In **PE**, we'll be playing football and focusing on our ABCs (Agility, Balance and Coordination)

Our RE focus this term is Sikhism

In **Music**, we'll be exploring pitch and rhythm and performing music to the correct tempo, as a group.

In Character Curriculum we'll be learning about the Zones of Regulation and how to develop positively during post-Lockdown.

In English we will be:

Starting our new Talk4Writing book; The Boy, The Mole, The Fox and The Horse by Charlie Mackesy. We will be using this book to help us write a cake recipe to give to mole. In writing, students will be learning how to join their words together to write a sentence. We will be focusing on neat letter formation, and using full stops and capital letters. The children will also be learning about adjectives and how to use them.

We will then be looking at Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers to help us to describe a story setting.

In Maths we will be learning about:

Autumn1: Numbers to 10, Addition and subtraction within 10

Autumn 2: Shapes and patterns, Numbers to 20 and Addition and subtraction

within 20

In Spanish, we'll be finding out:

- About greetings
- Numbers to 10
- How the Spanish celebrate Christmas

In Computing, we will be introducing Seesaw and learning how to use it independently in our learning.

In Art we will be investigating mark making and looking at the work of Wassily Kandinsky to explore primary and secondary colours. We will then be looking at illustrators and illustrating our own stories. In the second half of term we will be painting self portraits and inventing vehicles.
