(Theme: Under the sea)


Timbre and rhythmic patterns

## English

Children will be Telling stories and retelling incidents from their own experience mainly making appropriate tense choices, using character names and basic sequencing. They'll be learning to become very familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales, retelling them and considering their particular characteristics. The children will sequence sentences to form short narratives, re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense and discuss what they have written with the teacher or other pupils.
