Every day is vital - please make sure that your child does not miss school unless they are seriously unwell. Holidays in term time are not permitted. Please let the school office know if your child is absent.




Your child is expected to bring in their reading folder everyday so that letters and books can be brought home for you and your child to read.

In our History 'Toys' topic, Year 1 will be sequencing toys into a physical timeline, children investigate artefacts from the past and begin to pose questions. They learn how teddy bears have changed and 'interview' an old teddy bear before considering what toys may be like in the future.



In our first Science 'Sensitive bodies' topic, Year 1 will be Identifying and naming body parts, exploring our five senses and conducting practical activities with the senses to spot patterns and answer questions.

In Character Curriculum, we will be learning about:

In Spanish, we will be learning about:

In my town (Moving On) Recognise, recall, and remember up to 7 places from our town in Spanish. Attempt to spell some of these nouns with their correct indefinite article/determiner. Attempt to build a sentence using the structure 'hay' (there is) plus the noun and the correct indefinite article/determiner.

In Computing we will:

Explore algorithms through a variety of cross curricular unplugged activities. They will also be exposed to digital devices for programming, as part of continuous provision.
