

In <u>Art</u>, we will be learning about:

This term Year 2 will be creating sculptures and looking at castles around the world for inspiration.

They will work with clay to explore complex shapes and experiment with how to recreate texture. Alongside the sculptural work they will also develop their drawing, collage and digital art making skills.

# In Geography, we are looking at why our world is wonderful:

- Identify and locate characteristics of the UK on a map.
- Identify human and physical features.
- Locate human and physical features on a world map.
- Explain the difference between oceans and seas.
- Name and locate the five oceans on a world map.
- Use an aerial photograph to draw a simple sketch map.
- Collect data



# In <u>Science</u>, we are looking at materials:

- Name objects with the same use that are made from different materials.
- Name materials that are used to make objects with different uses.
- Recognise that stretching, twisting, bending and squashing can cause some solid objects to change shape.
- Name properties that make materials suitable for their use.
- Measure using non-standard units.
- Use data to answer a simple question.

# In <u>PE,</u> we will be learning about: Gymnastics!

This half term we have exciting lessons of gymnastics! We are looking out our range of movement skills, balancing, jumping and rolling skills!

Recognise, recall, and remember the 6 colours presented in Spanish.
Recognise and remember the high frequency verbs:

'I am called', 'I have', 'I live', 'I am' and 'I know how to...'.

Present and describe themselves as a superhero.

### In my town (Moving On)

Recognise, recall, and remember up to 7 places from the town in Spanish.

Attempt to spell some of these nouns with their correct indefinite article/determiner.

Attempt to build a sentence using the structure 'hay' (there is) plus the noun and the correct indefinite article/determiner.

### In **Music** we will be learning about:

Musical me- Dynamics, timbre, tempo and motifs (Theme: Space)
