Your child will be set homework every Friday. It must be completed by the following


Homework will be set via EdShed for spellings and times tables practice.

<u>English</u>

Our Spring 1 Talk for Writing focus text is Voices in the Park where we will be learning to write a recount and will then focus on writing a letter. During Spring 2 our focus text is The Manor House where we will be writing a suspense text and a diary.

Our core reading texts are Stig of the Dump (Spr 1) and Journey to Jo'burg (Sor 2) which will be use to help develop our reading skills.



VOICES



<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this term we will be focusing on:

- Division and partitioning
- Short division
- Equivalent fractions
- Mixed and improper fractions
- Adding and subtracting fractions
- Analogue to digital time
- Converting units of time
- Decimal equivalents to tenths, quarters and halves
- Compare and order numbers with same number of decimal places
- Multiply and divide by 10 and 100 including decimals
- Area and perimeter of rectangles and rectilinear shapes

In <u>Art</u>, we will be learning about:

This term Year 4 will be looking at patterns in art. They will explore patterns created by a range of artists as well as patterns they see around them in nature. To experiment with their own pattern designs they will use printing techniques, clay engraving and painting.

In <u>Music</u> we will be learning about:

South America Haiku Music and Performance (Theme: Hanami)

In <u>Character Curriculum,</u> we will be learning about:

> Dreams and Goals Healthy Me

Our <u>**RE focus**</u> this term is

Christianity (Values, How beliefs are expressed, reflect and personal growth)

Food and Fasting (Rituals, Ceremonies and Lifestyles, Values) In Spanish, we will be learning about:

Presenting myself (Intermediate) Count to 20. Say our name and age. Say hello and goodbye and then ask how somebody is feeling and answer how they are feeling. Tell you where we live. Tell you my nationality and understand basic gender agreement rules

Instruments

In **<u>Computing</u>**, we will be learning about:

- Making shapes with Logo (Computer science)
 - Data logging

In <u>PE</u>, we this term be learning about: Gymnastics!

We are learning about all the different movement skills, individual development of balances, using a spring board, ways of movement and creating our own mini performances! Next half term we will be learning about Basketball, the range of skills and matches!

In our History topic How hard was it to invade and settle in Britain we will be learning about:

- Who the Anglo-Saxons and the Scots were
- How the Anglo-Saxons settled in Britain
- What Sutton Hoo tells us about the Anglo-Saxons
- How Christianity arrived in Britain
- Making interpretations of King Alfred
- How the Anglo-Saxon ruled ended

In our **Geography** topic on **where our food comes from** we will be learning about:

- How our food choices can impact the environment
- Responsible trade
- How we get our chocolate
- How far our food travels
- The advantages and disadvantages of buying local and imported food.

In **Science** during Spring 1 we will be focusing on *States of Matter*. We will look at classifying solids, liquids and gases, as well as condensation and evaporation.

In Spring 2 we will be learning about Sound and Vibrations where we will understand that sound travels from an object (usually the air), into the ear, down the ear canal and to the brain.
