In our <u>Roots, Shoots and Fruits</u> topic, we will be learning about:

- Observing plants over time
- Sorting and classifying plants based on their specific features
- Research different types of plants in my local community
- Record and represent data

In our **<u>Earth as an Island</u>** topic, we will be learning about:

- use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate islands and describe features
- use the eight points of a compass,
- use fieldwork to observe, measure, record and present the human and physical features of islands

In <u>Art</u>, we will be exploring the topic illustration and imagination. We will study the work and processes of professional illustrators and experiment with our own styles, ideas and techniques. This topic will help us to develop our problem solving skills through activities such as responding to words through art and working from a brief.

Carmen: Pupils learn the famous opera tune Toreador by Bizet and consider character and drama. Romantic period.

In <u>Dance</u> this term, Year 5 will be focusing on learning the core dance moves in both the ballet & jazz dance discipline, as well as their own creativity as a dancer. Not only will we be perfecting our dance routines, but there will be opportunities for them to choreograph their own dances within small groups, ensuring they are thinking about pathways, spacing and dynamics. Our main focus will be teamwork, memory skills and stamina.
