Every day is vital - please make sure that your child does not miss school unless they are seriously unwell. Holidays in term time are not permitted. Please let the school office know if your child is absent.





- Identify the different phases in the Battle of Britain.
- Make inferences and deductions about a photograph.
- Describe how children may have felt when evacuated.
- Evaluate the accuracy and reliability of sources.

Our <u>RE focus</u> this term is What Matters Most? Crucifixion (Rituals, Ceremonies and Lifestyles, Values) <u>In Spanish</u>, we will be learning about: Do you have a pet? (Intermediate) Repeat, recognise and attempt to spell the 8 nouns (including the correct article for each) for pets in Spanish. Tell somebody in Spanish if they have or do not have a pet. Ask somebody else in Spanish if they have a pet. Tell somebody in Spanish the name of their pet. Attempt to create a longer phrase using the conjunctions y ("and") or pero ("but").
