




Exploring Identity- That we can use techniques such as working with layers to help create imagery which reflects the complex nature of our identities.


That as viewers we can then "read" imagery made by other people, unpicking imagery, line, shape, colour to help us understand the experience of the artist.

- Make inferences and deductions about a photograph.
- Describe how children may have felt when evacuated.
- Evaluate the accuracy and reliability of sources.
- Describe the impact WW2 had on women's lives

- Explain how our circulatory systems work
- Name the key parts of our circulatory system
- Explore how our digestive system turns food into fuel
- Explore what is in our blood and how it keeps us healthy
