



In Reception our Understanding the World topics are fluid and do tend to change quickly as we follow the interests of the children however below is our current plan to support settling into their new class. We currently have our role play area set up as a vet as we are exploring woodland animals and will change it as the topics change.

In our woodland animals theme we are learning about:

- Owl life cycle
- Animals that live in the woods
- Non fiction books about woodland animals.
- Reading fiction stories (Owl babies, the very helpful maganage rough)
- Recognising animal footprints



- Talking and showing pictures about all the different families in our class and in other families.
- Creating a woodland animals small world
- Creating family portraits
- How do vets help animals?
- Facts about different types of transport
- How do you get to school? How does someone from another country get to school?
- Creating different transports in creative ways
- Exploring non fiction stories about animals, transport and seasons.

<u>Literacy</u>

We will be using our phonics sessions and the texts Owl Babies and Handa's Surprise to support:

- Hearing and recognising initial sounds
- Sequencing a familiar story
- Letter formation
- Name writing
- Hearing the sounds in a word and blending them together,

<u>Maths</u>

- Matching equal and unequal sets
- Comparing and ordering objects and sets
- Ordering and representing numbers 1 - 6
- Recognise, describe, copy and extend colour and size patterns
- Explore addition and subtraction to 6
- Estimate, order compare, discuss and explore capacity, weight and lengths

In <u>Character Curriculum</u>, we will be learning about:

- Being Me in my World
- Celebrating differences

In <u>PE</u>, we will be learning about:
Fundamentals through games..
By learning how to play team games using lots of skills, We also look at our independent learning and how we can use different equipment to play different games. Next half term we will be developing our fundamentals further.

<u>In Spanish,</u> we will be learning about:

- Giving commands
- Asking for water or to go to the toilet
- Learning a 'tidy up' song in Spanish

In <u>Art</u> we will be learning about colour and mark-making, using a range of tools. Taking inspiration for each activity from story books and illustrations. Learning how to create a story and represent it through illustrations. Other skills: collage drawing, painting.
